

## Year 2 Snail Poems

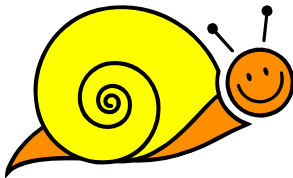
### My Snail Poem

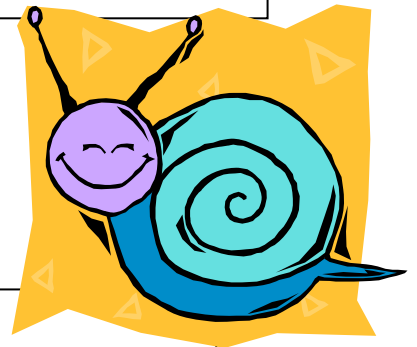
### My Snail Poem
